#### **RSD Support Programme for the CEA**

Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s),

The Royal School Dungannon is offering a Support Programme for pupils wishing to take the Common Entrance Assessment (CEA) administered by AQE. As you will probably know the CEA is the entrance test used by RSD for entry into Year 8.

The Support Programme consists of two parts with a distinct and different focus in each. Both are aimed at supporting **current Primary 6 pupils** who are interested in sitting the CEA and applying to RSD for Year 8 entry in September 2019.

#### 1. The RSD 'CEA Summer School'

The summer school is aimed at pupils who have had **limited** exposure to the CEA. Its intention is to introduce current Primary 6 pupils to the format of the CEA and to provide support classes covering some of the topics which feature on the test.

The summer school will run for 6 sessions (3 on literacy and 3 on numeracy topics) on the following dates. Each session will be held in RSD, **starting at 4.00 pm and finishing at 5.30 pm**, and the sessions will be led by an experienced primary school teacher. All materials will be provided on the day, free of charge. Please use the Main Entrance to the School on Ranfurly Road.

#### 2. The RSD 'CEA Workshops'

The CEA workshop will run in September and October and is aimed at pupils who have **already undertaken** preparation and practice for the CEA. The workshop will focus on topics identified as challenging and provide an opportunity for pupils to practise questions on these topics and reinforce their understanding.

Further details about the workshop will be provided in September but it is envisaged that the sessions will be held in RSD and led by an experienced primary school teacher with all materials provided on the day.
